Bowral & District Hospital Redevelopment

Preserving history in the Outpatient Centre

Beautiful timber flooring dating from the 1930s has been discovered during work on the new state-of-the-art Outpatient Centre, the centrepiece of Bowral & District Hospital's Stage 2 \$55 million redevelopment.

Hospital General Manager Bradley Warner said the old administration building was being transformed into a modern outpatient centre with a focus on preserving and enhancing its historical features.

"The building dates from the 1930s and it has been wonderful to uncover some of its history during the renovations," Mr Warner said.

Known as 'The OC', the new centre includes a full suite of allied health services, cardiac assessment, pathology, medical clinics, purpose-built treatment spaces and a modern gymnasium.

It complements the hospital's new Clinical Services Building completed in 2020 as part of the \$68.7 million Stage 1 redevelopment.

Mr Warner said other Stage 2 works underway included the development of the Aboriginal Dreaming Garden, installation of a new lift in the Clinical Services Building and internal refurbishment of Milton Park to create an administration/back-of-house centre.

"This is an exciting time for our hospital and community and I am delighted with the progress of the Stage 2 works," he said.
