Currently there are vacancies in the 3-5 year old age group.



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

New Food Heating System for Fairfield

Fairfield Hospital now has a new food heating system equal to any in the State. The new delivery system uses single tray, dual compartment technology, which simultaneously chills cold food and heats hot food within the trolley. South Western Sydney Food Services Sector Manager Glenn Patman said: Fairfield's new system would help ensure that all meals are served at the correct temperature on new attractive meal trays and trolleys increase the

consistency of meal service times.

"The commissioning and implementation went like clockwork thanks to the dedicated Food Services staff and their supervisors, who ensured all staff were trained and ready to go from the very first meal service." Glenn said.

The new system has received positive feedback from Fairfield patients with regards to improved consistency of meal temperature and presentation.

The introduction of the new carts is part of

a significant investment by HealthShare NSW in food rethermalisation carts and the improvement of ages kitchens across NSW public

hospitals.

Nutrition & Dietetics Department @ Fairfield

The Nutrition and Dietetics department at Fairfield Hospital has three full time dietitians, three part time dietitians and eight diet technicians.

The dietitians work from 8.30am to 5pm Monday to Friday.

The department provides inpatients and outpatients services:

Outpatients' services:

Individual consultations are provided in: diabetes clinic, gestational diabetes clinic, general nutrition clinic for people with high cholesterol levels, heart disease, gastrointestinal disorders and for people who are malnourished or at risk of malnourishment.

Group educations: Two sessions per month for people who are newly diagnosed with type 2 diabetes. 2 sessions a month for participants in cardiac rehabilitation program.

Other group education programs are also coordinated with multicultural health workers and are directed towards various community groups.

You may contact the Nutrition and Dietetics department on 96168510 for more information and/or to get an appointment to see a dietitian. If you have made an appointment to see a dietitian, you will need to bring a referral letter from your GP. Interpreters can be arranged upon request.

As part of nutrition initiative program for the staff to prevent or manage chronic diseases e.g. diabetes, heart disease, our department will be writing articles on nutrition matters.
