## Construction update

Work is continuing on Phase 2 of the Stage 2 redevelopment of Bowral & District Hospital with completion now expected in 2026.

We look forward to welcoming our HealthShare colleagues into their new space on the ground floor of the former Milton Park building in the first quarter of 2026.

Work is forging ahead in the new **General Services Building** with construction of fire stairs on the eastern end now complete, the ground floor fitout is progressing well, and the loading dock and forecourt are also taking shape.

# Round up of 2025

It has been a busy year on campus with key milestones reached including:

- Completion and opening of Outpatient Centre (OC)
- Demolition of Watson Rehabilitation Centre
- New back-of-house lift commissioned in Clinical Services Building (CSB)
- New linkways providing enclosed connection across the campus from the OC through to the CSB.
- Artwork installations in the OC and on the Emergency Department windows
