

## Early works, take hold

The early works for our hospital redevelopment are well under way. These works called 'enabling' are the required works to get the site ready for construction. These works consist of three (3) projects: Mona Rd access, new carpark and improved pathology access leading to changes to Clinical Information Department Remodelling and new ambulance entrance. These works are scheduled to continue until the end of August 2018 and we are working closely with Hutchinson Builders to minimise disruption to patients, families, staff and community.

## What has been done?

- ◆ Schematic Design meetings complete.
- ◆ Detailed design development meetings have commenced
- ◆ Ongoing staff and community updates of progress.
- ◆ Redevelopment Notice Board has been installed (outside of Children's Ward)
- ◆ Government Records Repository GRR have relocated approx 110,000 clinical records to secondary and off site storage with support and assistance from our amazing Clinical Information Department Staff
