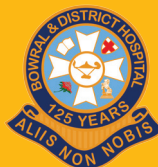

## PRIMARY SCHOOL ART COMPETITION

### **Terms & Conditions**

1. Open to primary school students of Wingecarribee Shire.
2. One entry per student
3. One A3 canvas board (white) supplied for each entry. Artwork must not exceed this size.
4. The theme is "children building better health" which may be interpreted however students see fit.
5. The number "125" must be used somewhere within the piece.
6. Mediums such as paint, crayon, pencil, texta, collage and other flat mediums are acceptable.
7. Canvases can be collected during business hours from BDCU, 411 Bong Bong Street, Bowral between Tuesday, 1 July 2014 and Thursday, 7 August 2014.
8. An entry form must be completed to receive a canvas.
9. All artworks must be delivered to BDCU, 411 Bong Bong Street, Bowral by Friday, 8 August 2014.
10. Judging will take place prior to the announcement of the winner at a celebration afternoon tea at Bowral & District Hospital at 3:30pm on Friday, 15 August 2014. Entrants will be informed of further details of this event upon submission of their artwork.
11. Judges will consider interpretation of the theme and inclusion of the number "125". In addition, the use of space, colour and originality will be considered.
12. The judges' decision is final.
13. Entries will be displayed at Bowral & District Hospital, BDCU and other local sites following the celebration afternoon tea.
14. The artwork awarded the Judges' Choice Prize will be reproduced, with recognition of the artist's name, on the napkins for the Bowral Long Lunch. The Bowral Long Lunch is to be held on Sunday, 19 October 2014.
15. All artworks will be displayed at the Bowral Long Lunch with a People's Choice Prize being awarded via ballot. This ballot will exclude the artwork awarded the Judges' Choice Prize.
16. Bowral & District Hospital will retain all artwork for an ongoing display in and around the Paediatric Ward.
