A FAIRFIELD West doctor has chosen to go dry in July, for the second time, to raise money for the Cancer Therapy Centre at Liverpool Hospital.

Dry July challenges people to go one month without drinking alcohol while raising funds through sponsorship.

Milica Aleksic is a multidisciplinary team co-ordinator and has been working at the centre for four years.

"I am the first point of contact between outside specialists and the cancer therapy department," she said.

"I organise the multidisciplinary meetings where the specialists would present the patient and discuss the best treatment for them."

Ms Aleksic says she hopes to raise as much money as she pos-

sibly can for this year's campaign.

"It is not my first time, I participated last year," she said.

"I have joined and I am supporting the Liverpool Cancer Therapy team, [because] I know what a difference it makes when patients come to our centre and we can offer them great services.

"My grandma was a patient here as well — she is now well and already five years cancer free."

Ms Aleksic said she would like to encourage other people to participate in Dry July this year.

"Many of us have been touched by a loved one or friend/workmate [who] has experienced cancer," she said.
