BRAVERY UNMASKED 2018 EXHIBITION

The Bravery Unmasked Exhibition has now commenced and will be on display until **18th November 2018** at the Casula Powerhouse Arts Centre.

In this exhibition radiation masks, used to immobilise the head in cancer treatment, are turned into artworks by patients, their family and supporters.

The radiation masks, each moulded to individual patients, serve as a symbol for the experience of cancer. *Bravery Unmasked* engages creativity to explore the impact of cancer from the perspective of those diagnosed as well as carers, family and friends. Healing is multi-faceted; whilst the medical system provides the necessary equipment and support to heal physically, responding to the mask allows the participants to create a new story around cancer.
