Welcome to the Child Assessment Team at Campbelltown Hospital.

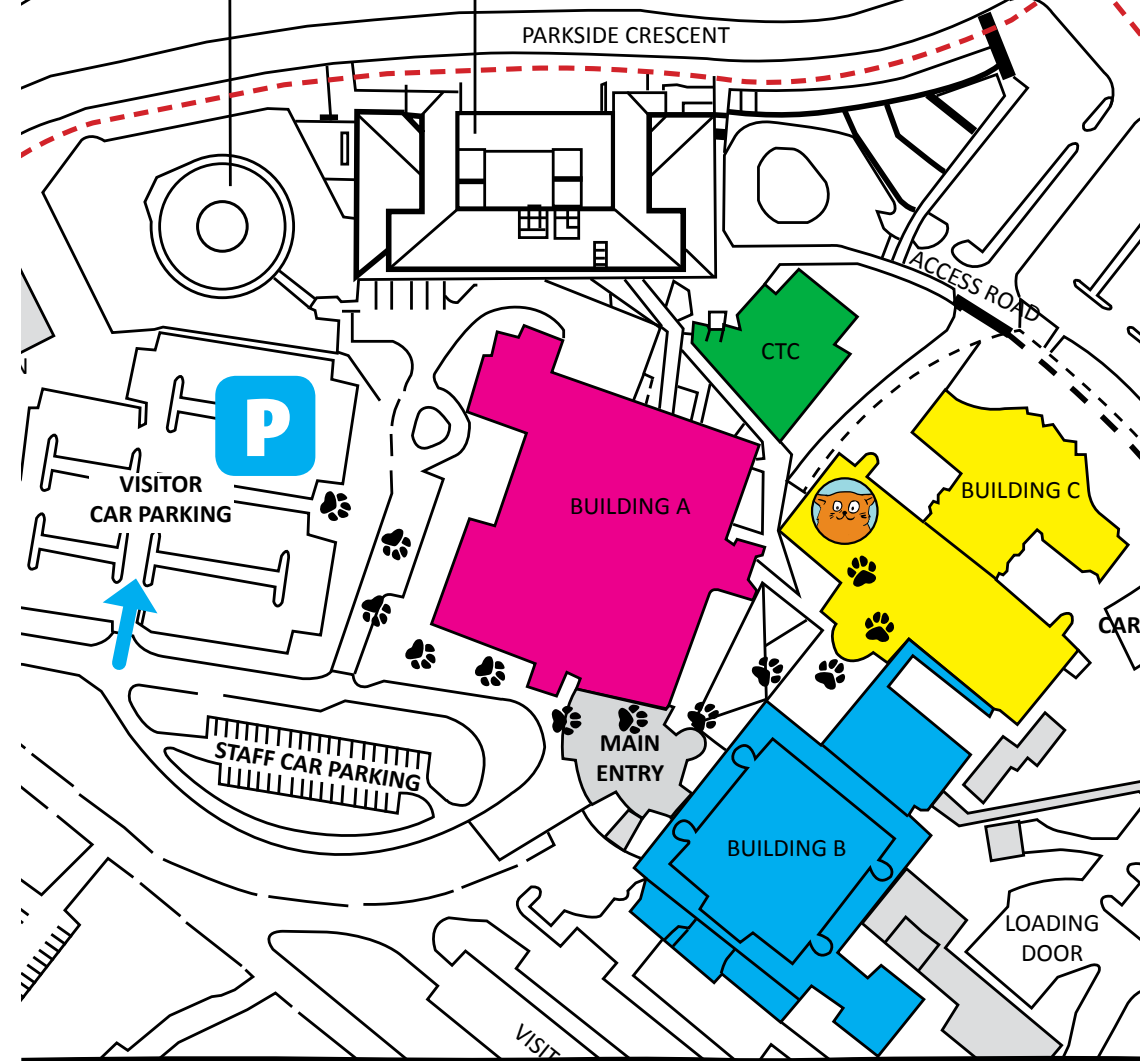
This booklet has been designed to prepare children for their assessment.

Our clinic is in the Paediatric Outpatients Department on the ground floor of Building C.

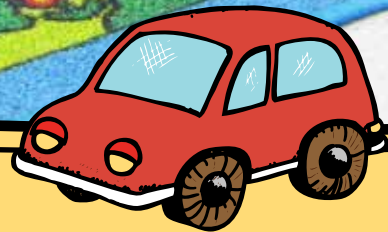


I am going to the CAT's room in the hospital.

and run.

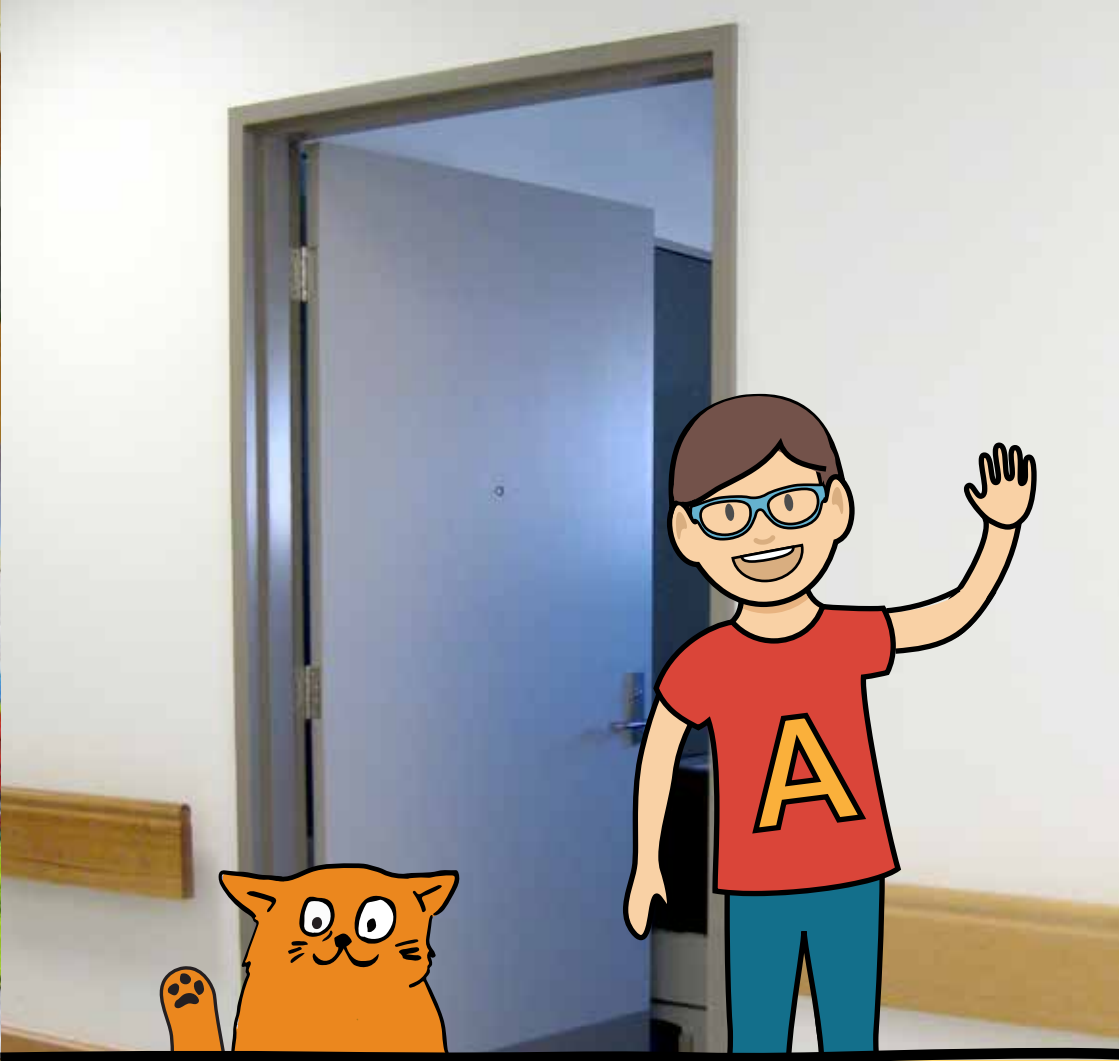


It's time for a break.
