



## BASIC COURSE

### Basic Assessment and Support in Intensive Care

The BASIC training course aims to teach participants to rapidly assess ill patients and provide initial treatment and organ support.

The course uses multidisciplinary teamwork simulation and interactive drills, lectures, and workshops, taught by Intensive Care specialists with emphasis on a practical approach to management of critically ill patients. The use of manikins assists in making the scenarios more realistic. Effective communication and teamwork is promoted throughout the course.

- Acute Respiratory Failure
- Airway Management
- Mechanical Ventilation
- Arrhythmias
- Transport of the Critically Ill Patient
- Haemodynamic Monitoring
- Shock
- Oliguria & Acute Renal Failure
- Severe Sepsis & Septic Shock
- Severe Trauma
- Neurological Emergencies
- Sedation, Nutrition, DVT & Stress Ulcer
- Arterial Blood Gases
- Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation

- Senior ICU Nurses
