The name change is because My Health Learning better reflects ownership and self management of online learning.

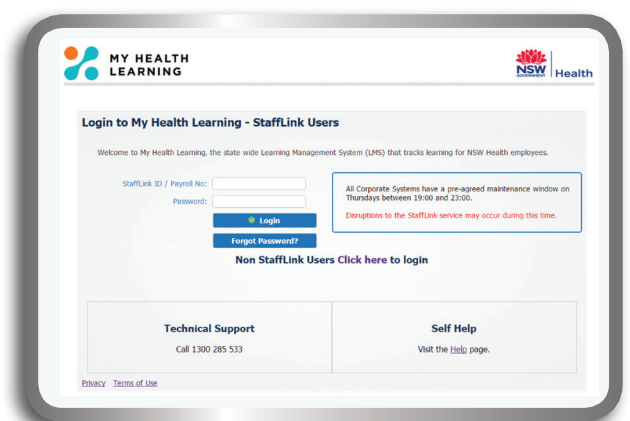
The refreshed user interface makes the system mobile friendly so learning can be accessed on a range of different devices including smart phones and tablets.

All existing bookmarked links will continue to work, and the eLearning system will retain the learning history for each user.

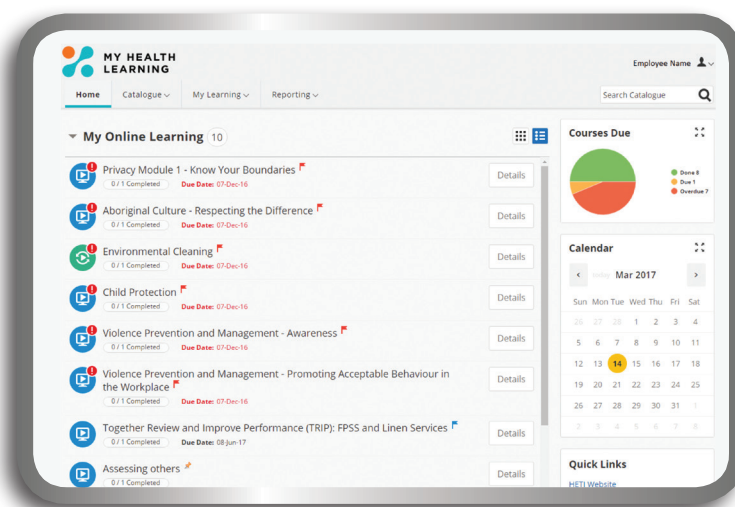
You can also type myhealthlearning.health.nsw.gov.au into your web browser or update your bookmarks/favourites at home.
