In August 2016 the students enrolled in the Certificate III Health Services Assistance (VET in Schools) and the Diploma of Nursing graduated from their respective courses. One hundred and fourteen students, their families and school representatives attended a graduation ceremony held at the Liverpool Catholic Club. The Certificates and Achievement Awards were presented by the SWSLHD Director of Nursing and Midwifery Services, Sonia Marshall.

Diploma of Nursing

Over the course of fourteen months students in the Diploma of Nursing spend time in the classroom, simulation labs and on clinical placement developing the skills and knowledge required of Enrolled Nurses employed in an acute health care setting. Most of the students have already gained employment as Enrolled Nurses in facilities throughout SWSLHD.

Certificate III in Health Services Assistance (Vet in Schools)

This is a 2 year program which forms part of the students' HSC subjects for Year 11 and Year 12. During the course students spend one afternoon per week learning about the role that Assistants In Nursing (AINs) play in the acute health care setting and undertaking clinical placements during their school holidays. Whilst on clinical placement students are expected to assist in all of their patients care and support activities relevant to their role as the course progresses. They start with being able to perform hand hygiene, and bed making to being able to perform clinical observations and basic wound care. The students are amazed at their progress over the two years and many gain employment in our facilities as AINs at the end of the course.
