09-Jan-24	<a href="#">Public Interest Disclosures</a>	The Mandatory Training Standing Committee (MTSC) has endorsed that: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>Public Interest Disclosures Training for People Managers (496662700)</i> be state-wide mandatory (red flagged) for all people managers across the NSW Health system.</li> <li><i>Public Interest Disclosures Training for Disclosure Officers (496658718)</i> be mandatory for all staff appointed as Disclosure Officers by their Health Agency.</li> </ol>
28-Sep-23	<a href="#">Covid Vaccination Training Program</a>	The Australian Government Department of Health and Aged Care (DoHAC) has advised that their mandatory COVID-19 Vaccination Training Program (CVTP) will be ending on 1 October 2023. From 1 October 2023, clinicians participating in the administration of COVID-19 vaccines will no longer be required to complete the COVID-19 vaccine training modules listed above and the DoHAC learning platform will close.
29-May-23	<a href="#">Bloodsafe® Clinical Transfusion Practice</a>	The Mandatory Training Standing Committee (MTSC) has endorsed that targeting to Clinical Transfusion Practice (MHL Course Code: 42063551) for Child and Family Health Nurses be changed from state-wide to locally determined (red flag) mandatory training.
16-Sep-22	<a href="#">Assistants in Medicine Mandatory Training and Targeting</a>	The Mandatory Training Standing Committee (MTSC) has endorsed Assistant in Medicine (AiM) mandatory training requirements (red flag) and how this training is targeted to staff. The training is a subset of Junior Medical Officer requirements and considers the mandatory training the AiM has completed during their student assignment. Specifying mandatory training requirements for AiMs will ensure consistent training for AiMS across NSW Health and contribute to patient and staff safety and improved patient care.

03-Feb-22	<a href="#">Student Mandatory Training: Donning and fit checking of P2 or N95 respirators in NSW healthcare settings</a>	The Mandatory Training Standing Committee (MTSC), in consultation with the NSW Respiratory Protection Program Board and the Clinical Excellence Commission (CEC) has endorsed that Donning and fit checking of P2 or N95 respirators in NSW healthcare settings be mandatory for all students on placement in NSW Health. This will support students' respiratory protection and is an important clinical safety measure as part of the COVID-19 response.
28-Jan-22	<a href="#">Aboriginal Health Worker and Aboriginal Health Practitioner Mandatory Training and Targeting</a>	The Mandatory Training Standing Committee (MTSC) has endorsed changes to Aboriginal Health Worker (AHW) and Aboriginal Health Practitioner (AHP) mandatory training requirements (red flag) and how this training is targeted to staff.

28-Jan-22	<a href="#">Post Graduate Student Midwives Targeting</a>	The Mandatory Training Standing Committee (MTSC) in consultation with the Clinical Excellence Commission and the Nursing and Midwifery Office, Ministry of Health has endorsed mandatory training targeting changes for post graduate student midwives. Post graduate student midwives will be: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Excluded from Perinatal Safety Education (Fetal and Maternal Pathways) targeting.</li> <li>2. Targeted to Between the Flags - Tier 1: Awareness, Charts and Escalation (Course Code: 90688727).</li> </ol>
19-Oct-21	<a href="#">Visiting Medical Officers in 'On Extended Leave' User Group in My Health Learning</a>	The Mandatory Training Standing Committee (MTSC) has supported excluding Visiting Medical Officers (VMOs) from the My Health Learning (MHL) 'On Extended Leave' User Group. This administrative change does not affect VMO mandatory training requirements, which remain the same.
10-Sep-21	<a href="#">Deteriorating Patient – Maternity Client Learning Pathway (Tier 2): De-Targeting</a>	The Mandatory Training Standing Committee (MTSC), in consultation with the Clinical Excellence Commission (CEC) has endorsed that the new Perinatal Safety Education replaces the Tier 2 components of the Deteriorating Patient – Maternity Client Learning Pathway.

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30-Aug-21	<a href="#">Infection Control Modules for Students</a>	<p>The Mandatory Training Standing Committee (MTSC) has endorsed two infection control modules as mandatory for all students on placement in NSW Health. This will support NSW Health to continue to accommodate student placements on a risk assessment basis wherever possible.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Infection Prevention and Control Practices - Clinical</li> <li>• Personal Protective Equipment for Combined Transmission Based Precautions</li> </ul>

01-Jul-21	<a href="#">Perinatal Safety Education: New Maternal Safety Learning Pathway</a>	<p>The Mandatory Training Standing Committee (MTSC) has endorsed the new Perinatal Safety Education – Maternal Safety Learning Pathway for all midwives, obstetricians and obstetric medical trainees.</p>
18-May-21	<a href="#">Smoking Cessation: Brief Intervention in Oral Health Settings</a>	<p>The Mandatory Training Standing Committee (MTSC) has endorsed a new eLearning course, Smoking Cessation: Brief Intervention in Oral Health Settings, as mandatory for all NSW Health dental practitioners and dental assistants.</p>

06-Apr-21	<a href="#">Cyber Security Fundamentals</a>	<p>The Mandatory Training Standing Committee has endorsed a new eLearning course, Cyber Security Fundamentals, as mandatory for all NSW Health Staff, contractors and students undertaking placements in NSW Health facilities. The training supports PD2020_046 Electronic Information Security policy requirements.</p>
06-Apr-21	<a href="#">Sexual Safety Policy Training</a>	<p>The Mandatory Training Standing Committee has endorsed removing the mandatory training requirement for Sexual Safety Policy Training for both managers and staff. The training will be de-targeted (Red Flag removed) on 16 April 2021. This decision affects mental health staff working in public mental health services, who were previously locally targeted to this training.</p>
06-Apr-21	<a href="#">Violence, Abuse and Neglect (VAN)</a>	<p>The Mandatory Training Standing Committee (MTSC) has endorsed a request by the Prevention and Response to Violence Abuse and Neglect (PARVAN) Unit, Ministry of Health and the NSW Health Education Centre Against Violence (ECAV) to de-target Violence, Abuse and Neglect (VAN) training.</p>

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11-Mar-21	<a href="#">Between the Flags – Deteriorating Patient Learning Pathway - Paediatric Face-to-face workshop for medical officers</a>	The Mandatory Training Standing Committee has endorsed that face-to-face training for Medical Officers who work with paediatric patients will be 'required', rather than 'optional' within the Between the Flags - Deteriorating Patient Learning Pathway - Paediatric patients (Medical).
02-Mar-21	<a href="#">ims+ How to Notify an Incident</a>	ims+ How to Notify an Incident training will be state-wide targeted (red-flagged) from 19 March 2021. The training is state-wide targeted to all NSW Health staff. While the previous training, IIMS Notifier Training, was mandated for all LHD/SN staff, the ims+ How to Notify an Incident training targeting has been extended to all NSW Health staff across all Health Agencies, including medical officers.
25-Feb-21	<a href="#">National COVID-19 Vaccination Training Program</a>	The Mandatory Training Standing Committee (MTSC) has endorsed the National COVID-19 Vaccination Training Program and the NSW Health Vaccine Storage and Cold Chain Management Module as mandatory for all NSW Health staff who will administer or manage COVID-19 Vaccines.
09-Dec-20	<a href="#">BloodSafe® eLearning Australia</a>	The MTSC has endorsed training requirements for all staff involved in transfusion related activities. These are outlined in the Policy Directive PD2018_042 Blood Management and comply with the National Safety and Quality Health Service Standards.
23-Sep-20	<a href="#">Roll out of Updated Incident Management Training</a>	NSW Health is replacing the current Incident Information Management System (IIMS) with a new incident management system known as ims+. To prepare staff for the new incident notification system, ims+ How to Notify an Incident (ims+ training) will replace the current IIMS Notifier Training. All staff must complete the new training.
26-May-20	<a href="#">Perinatal Safety: New education pathway</a>	The Mandatory Training Standing Committee has endorsed the Perinatal Safety Education pathway, to replace the NSW Fetal welfare assessment, Obstetric emergencies and Neonatal resuscitation Training ©, otherwise known as FONT. The training remains targeted to Obstetricians and Midwives.
26-May-20	<a href="#">Recognition and Management of Patients who are Deteriorating</a>	All clinicians who provide direct patient care must complete the mandatory Between the Flags Tier one and Tier two education and training prior to or during their induction to the health service, as outlined in the Deteriorating Patient Education Strategy.
21-Apr-20	<a href="#">Personal Protective Equipment for Combined Transmission-Based Precautions</a>	The Mandatory Training Standing Committee has endorsed a new eLearning course, Personal protective equipment (PPE) for combined transmission-based precautions. The training is state-wide targeted to all NSW Health staff.
18-Dec-19	<a href="#">Violence Prevention and Management – Team Restraint Techniques</a>	The MTSC has endorsed a change to the training frequency requirement for Violence Prevention and Management - Team Restraint Techniques to align with relevant NSW Health Policy Directives. The frequency of mandatory face to face training will change from every 5 years to once only and then be supported and reinforced by drills.
