An Analyst Programmer is a person who is involved with the development and/or maintenance of information systems.

Roles of an Analyst Programmer

- Analysis activity in preparation for programming tasks
- Documentation of the analysis activity (including flowcharting)
- Development of programming code
- Debugging of programming code
- Unit and system testing
- Program documentation
