ARC Advanced Life Support Level 2

The Australian Resuscitation Council Advanced Life Support Level 2 is a standardised national course for healthcare professionals. All applicants must hold a professional healthcare qualification and a current clinical or healthcare educational appointment. This course is very intense, and prior clinical knowledge and experience of critically ill patients are essential.

Course Features:

- Two-day face-to-face with supporting manual / pre and post MCQ
- Prior competence in CPR required
- Practical workshops and simulations
- Course material uses current ARC / NZRC Guidelines
- Recognised by the Resuscitation Council of the UK, New Zealand (NZRC) and Europe (ERC)

- Compliance with Safety and Quality Improvement Guide Standard 9

- 4-year validity of certification

- Causes and prevention of cardiopulmonary arrest
- Acute coronary syndromes

- Airway management
- Rhythm recognition and 12-lead ECG interpretation
- Arrhythmias, ABG analysis and cardiac arrest in special circumstances
- Continuous assessment during the course, post-course Cardiac Arrest Simulation Test and MCQ Paper.
