Liverpool Hospital is the second oldest hospital in Australia starting as a tent hospital in the 1790s. In 1813, the first permanent hospital structure was built. For nearly 200 years, we have had a proud and esteemed role in the delivery of healthcare in South Western Sydney. We have continued to grow with the community that we serve.

In February 2011, the new Clinical Building was opened and in 2012 the refurbishment of the existing Clinical Building and the Cancer Therapy Centre will be complete.

Liverpool Hospital will have the capacity for 855 beds, 23 operating theatres and 60 intensive care beds.

Liverpool Hospital is a major trauma centre for NSW and has strong commitments to research and teaching making us one of the busiest tertiary Hospitals in Australia, teaching medical students, nurses and allied health staff.
