

BASIC – Basic Assessment and Support in Intensive Care

BASIC course is a two-day course consisting of lectures, skill stations and tutorials designed for junior critical care trainees and taught by Intensive Care specialists with emphasis on a practical approach to management of critically ill patients.

Originally developed by Chinese University of Hong Kong, this international course is adapted to reflect best practice relevant to Intensive Care in Australia. Course is designed to teach assessment of critically ill, resuscitation, treatment and initial organ support for critically ill patients.
