Hospital quilts restored

As part of its 125 year anniversary Bowral & District Hospital has restored three (banners) quilts created in 1990.

Bowral & District Hospital General Manager Alison Derrett said the original idea for the quilts came from staff who were inspired by the work of Malcolm King, designer of banners and Yvonne Line, a fabric artist who was known for working with local communities to create 'community memories'.

"We wanted to breathe new life into the quilts because they're an important part of our history, one that reflects the Hospital's close ties with the local community.

"The quilts look fantastic after their restoration and I look forward to sharing them with our staff, patients and the community," she said.

Banner 1 – was designed and created by hospital staff and volunteers and depicts the work around the Hospital.

Banner 2- was designed by TAFE students, staff and volunteers and depicts memories from the town landmarks and environment.

Banner 3- was designed by local schools and depicts life in the town from a child's point of view.
