Safe Haven A new approach to suicide prevention



Safe Haven offers a different kind of immediate and professional support to ED and other traditional services for people experiencing suicidal crisis.







Safe. Non-judgemental. Inclusive.

Free to access, no referral needed, no appointment required.

Person-centred support in times of crisis

Safe Haven peer support workers are trained to:

- Assess and de-escalate emergencies
- Develop safety plans

- Make appropriate referrals
- Fast-track emergency pathways as needed



Person-centred support means guests are listened to and are free to make decisions for themselves. Peer workers are there to ensure safety and provide support based on guests' immediate needs, preference and comfort level.

Peer workers understand what it's like to go through suicidal distress and have been comprehensively trained to support others. They create a safe and comfortable environment where guests are able to speak freely and openly.

What your patient can expect

Arriving at Safe Haven

Guests are greeted by a peer worker and will be asked to sign in. Guests are not required to show any form of identification to use this service. Safe Haven is a dedicated space to handle suicidal crisis, support is free and can be accessed immediately with no waiting times or referral needed.

Available support

Guests may choose to speak with a peer support worker, sit down with a book, play a game, watch a video, or have a cup of coffee/tea. There are no obligations or expectations. It is a dedicated space to relax, unwind and connect.

Confidential Expert Support

Safe Haven has a comprehensive confidentiality and privacy policy. Guests can also request to access the service anonymously. All peer support workers have undergone extensive training in providing trauma informed person-centred care, crisis care and managing emergencies. They can also fasttrack pathways to ED.

Taxi Vouchers

If it's difficult for your patient to get to Safe Haven with public transport, they can call us to arrange a free taxi ride. See contact details at the back.
